Alexandria Soccer Association (ASA) is pleased to announce the launch of a brand new website, asa-access4all.org, created to supplement their main website which shares registration based program information.

The primary goal of the new Access4All site is to create a valuable and accessible space to share ASA's impactful work in the community, beyond just wins and losses on the soccer field or futsal court.

ASA's Access4All Program has three distinct branches:

1. Free **after school and in-school programming** offered to students at every school in Alexandria;
2. **Scholarships and financial aid** support for children who participant in core ASA programming but do not have the financial resources to fully cover the cost of tuition;
3. Development and advocacy for **safe places to play and free equipment** in order to ensure all children have access to safe and fun soccer and futsal experiences if they wish to play.

Since their inception more than 50 years ago ASA has been committed to providing access to sports programming for all children and have worked hard to break down barriers to participation in their community and beyond. The new website highlights impact stories and successes that better share the ways they are supporting health and wellness in Alexandria, Virginia and the surrounding communities. Additionally, the new site resource shares the growing community needs and how you might be able to support the project.
